

ANNIE LEIBOVITZ Visits Outdoor Art Gallery Showing Her Photographs of The New York Times Building on December 12th

On **Monday December 12th**, **Annie Leibovitz** will visit “**Building the Times: Photographs by Annie Leibovitz**” – a 1,290-foot-long public art exhibit featuring 83 exclusive black-and-white images taken between July and November 2005.
